

Priority of Access Policy

Policy Statement

This policy has been developed to ensure the education and care service complies with the centres own Priority of Access Guidelines.

Procedures:

Fun 4 U will use its own priority of access to prioritise the waiting list and to allocate available education and care places to families.

When enrolling children in the centre the Director will consider:

- Priority 1: a child at risk of serious abuse or neglect
- Priority 2: a child of a single parent who satisfies, or of parents who both satisfy, the work/training/study test under Section 14 of the 'A New Tax System (Family Assistance) Act 1999'.
- Priority 3: any other child.

Within these three priority categories, precedence should also be given to children in:

- Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander families
- Families which include a person with a disability
- Families on lower incomes
- Families from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds
- Socially isolated families
- Single parent families
